**The Afternoon Amble** through the New Forest is kindly organised by the Dorset Austin 7 Club. Entry is free.

As last year, there will be an evening **Grill Bar** selling burgers, sausages, bacon baps, chips, soft drinks, teas, coffees and pastries. A chance to meet and chat in the marquee. You are welcome to bring your own booze.

**Camping** is available within the Beaulieu grounds. There are decent toilets but no showers. Campsite open from 2pm Friday to 10am Monday.

### **Sunday 2nd July**

**The Rally:** Concours, extensive Austin Autojumble, entertaining driving tests, Bring-n-Buy spares stall, 750MC club stand, displays, food & drink stalls, awards presentation. All Austin 7s and other Austins and pre-1976 cars are welcome.

The rally gate opens from 8.30am and cars should leave by 5.30pm. The rally entry fee includes a rally plaque, programme and optional entry to the concours and driving tests. There is no reduction for Friends of Beaulieu.

### **Beaulieu Museum and Grounds**

The rally entry ticket includes entrance to the National Motor Museum, Palace House and grounds on both days. All entrants, passengers and campers will need rally entry tickets.

### **Entry forms**

Rally entry forms must arrive by Friday 16th June and final details will be sent out by 23rd June. Late entries may not be judged and may be parked in a different section of the rally field.

The Rally and driving tests are 750MC A7 Championship points-scoring events.
